METHODOLOGY


The School Safety Advocacy Council (SSAC) conducted this professional industry survey of school-based law enforcement officers, school administrators and school safety professionals through an online survey company (Survey Monkey), with the results being analyzed and reported through Survey Monkey.

The short 6-question survey instrument was developed by staff at the School Safety Advocacy Council, in concert with leaders in the school safety field. The survey was distributed via e-mail, and no duplicate e-mail addresses or IP Addresses were allowed to complete the survey more than one time.




Do you support non-law enforcement school staff (teachers, counselors, administrators) having the authority to carry firearms on school property as a means to protect students?




Do you feel the level of training that you have been provided has adequately prepared you to deal with an active shooter at your school (s)?




Does your school and/or community have a program in place that addresses alternatives to criminal arrest (i.e. civil citation, teen court, restorative justice)?
